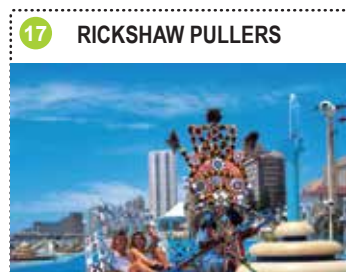



The Bluff is regarded as one of the best places in South Africa for whale watching. From June to Nov each year at WESSA Treasure Beach Education Centre one can enjoy land based whale viewing from the rooftop of the old WWII Radar Station. Have a picnic on the rooftop while spotting for whales.
