Getting There



From Durban and off the N2 North and South, a short twenty minute drive inland sees you passing through beautiful leafy suburbs and then climbing up to the beginning of the 1000 Hills routes. One can either take the main N3 road or the M13 scenic route and explore the well signposted Tour routes.

Coming down from inland on the N3 highway and about 45 kilometres past the City of Pietermaritzburg at the Cato Ridge village offramp, lies the vast majestic valley with numerous lookout stops.

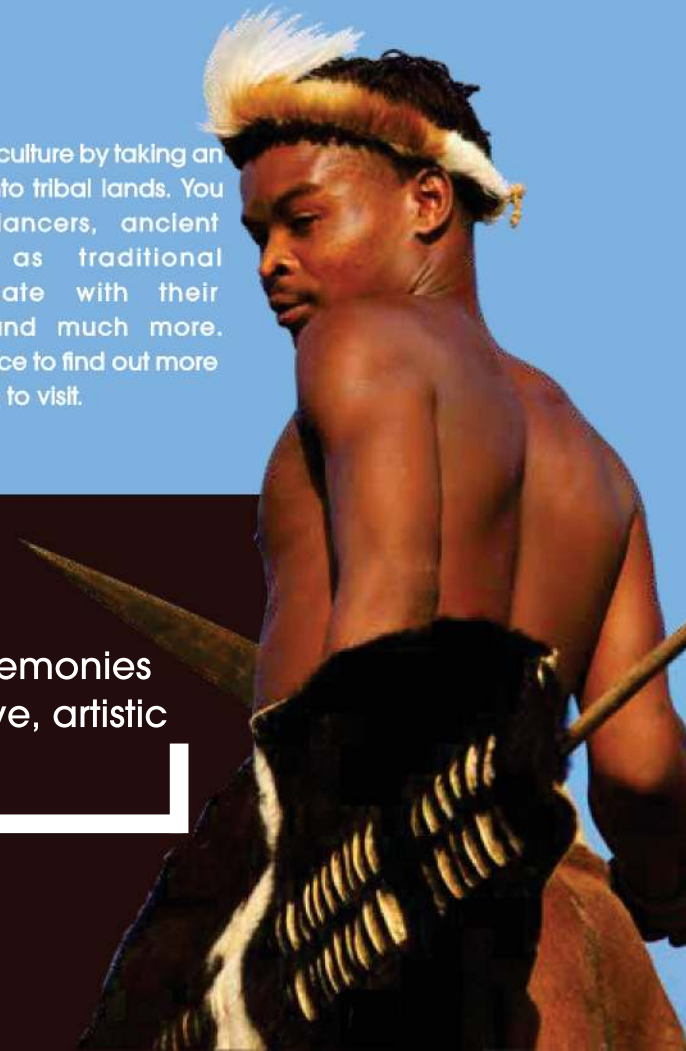
Explore the roots of Zulu culture

The Outer West is very fortunate to have several areas of outstanding beauty within its borders. One such area is Krantzklouf Nature Reserve which comprises the two main gorges or the Molweni & Nkutu rivers and a third secondary gorge. There are a number of waterfalls which after rain can be spectacular. The Reserve is home to a variety of flora & fauna ranging from Zebra to some very rare plants. There are two picnic sites, both of which are accessed from Kloof. There are several hiking trails most of which require a reasonable level of fitness owing to some fairly strenuous climbs out of the gorge. There are a number of rock faces which are suitable for rock climbing.

The land on which Krantzklouf Nature Reserve was proclaimed in 1952, was mainly on the farm Richmond no. 999 which from 1867 was owned by John Coote Field. After his death in 1897 and that of his wife, Elizabeth Catherina in 1902, the farm was divided between their 11 children and one grandson. The sons inheriting about 561 acres and the daughters about 400 acres.

In the 1880s the discovery of a large deposit of quartz led some locals to believe that there could be gold and an adit was dug into the cliffs but no records exist of any gold being found. The shaft goes well into the sandstone rock and the photo on the left shows the view from a short distance into the shaft

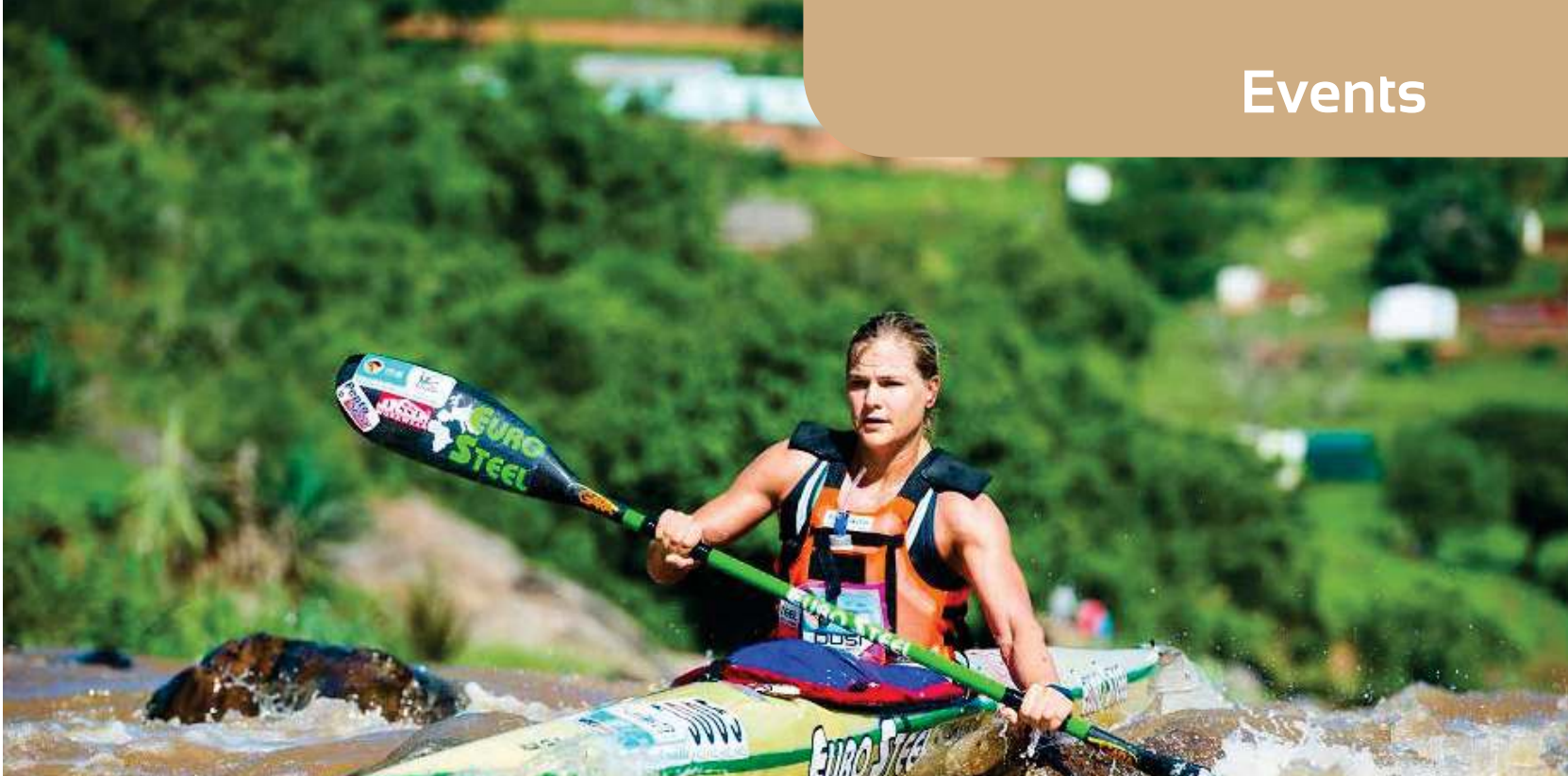

Inanda Dam is on the route of one of the world's most gruelling sporting events, the Dusi Canoe Marathon. Starting in Pietermaritzburg, contestants must paddle and run for three days along the Umsindusi and Umgeni rivers until they reach the sea in Durban. This tough event is held annually and attracts competitors from around the world to take on the might of the Valley of a 1000 Hills.

Big Events



The Comrades Marathon, run every year between Pietermaritzburg and Durban, has become the world's most renowned ultra-marathon. It owes its existence to a tough soldier named Vic Clapham, who, during the Great War of 1914-1918, fought and marched 1 700 miles across East Africa with the South African infantry in pursuit of Gen. Paul Von Lettow-Vorbeck's askari battalions. He decided to organise a marathon in memory of his comrades who suffered untold hardships during that epic march. The first Comrades Marathon took place on 24 May 1921, Empire Day, starting outside the City Hall in Pietermaritzburg with 34 runners. It has been held every year since then, with the exception of the war years of 1941-1945, and 2020 due to the Covid pandemic. The direction of the race alternates each year, the 'Down Run' being from Pietermaritzburg to Durban, and the 'Up Run' from Durban to Pietermaritzburg.

Events



The Amashova Durban Classic is a cycling race from Pietermaritzburg to Durban. This road race has three formats. The 106km race has surged in popularity over the last few years, with thousands of riders taking to the roads, cheered on by spectators as they whiz past.

The race takes the riders through the heart of the Valley of a 1000 Hills, The newest format is a 65km race that starts in Cato Ridge. Then there is the shorter 38km route starting in Hillcrest. All three races end at the Moses Mabida Stadium in Durban

Township Tourism

KwaNyuswa, Molweni, Shongweni, these are just some of the vibrant townships nestled among the Valley of a 1000 Hills. Young professionals unwind and network and party into the early hours of the morning at vibrant and exciting destinations like Magaba Lounge in Mpumalanga, 1000 Hills Lifestyle in KwaNyuswa. Tourists can be found enjoying traditional shisa nyama (barbecue), sampling the local favourite side dishes like chakalaka and madumbes while local residents swap stories of life in the townships while the chilled sounds of old school Jazz set the tempo at Khabza de Khabza in Shongweni.



Rural Tourism

It's not all just nightlife and parties though. Traditional rural Zulu villages can still be found nestled among the folds of these ancient hills where children splash about in the beautiful Umngeni River and the popular Inanda Dam, and where traffic jams are made up of cattle and goats. You can book a tour through one of the many tour operators and enjoy a guided experience exploring the Indondlo Cultural Village, Isithumba adventure Centre, and rural towns where a slower pace of life allows you to discover the culture, history and tradition of the Zulu people; meet a Zulu chief, a traditional Sangoma (spiritual healer) and learn about the importance of the Zulu friendship bracelet.



History and Culture

Much has been written about the arrival of the English & Dutch speaking settlers in Natal and the apparently uninhabited country over which the Dutch advance party crossed on its way from the Drakensberg to meet the English residents at the bay of Port Natal in October 1837. For the purposes of this introduction to the history of our area, suffice it to say that the Deed of Cession, on which the King of the Zulus, Dingaan, had placed his mark, before having the Dutch delegation killed, gave the Dutch 'for their everlasting property' the land from Port Natal to the Drakensberg, south of the Tugela river to the Transkei.

After much bloodshed in 1838 the Dutch began to allocate farming land to their followers. Still in existence are some of the Voortrekker records showing the informal way in which the Dutch settlers demarcated the farm land to farmers such as Andries Marthinus Laas of Salt River farm, now Pinetown area, Johannes Janie Potgietor of Assagai Kraal, now Botha's Hill & Alverstone area and Evert Fredrik Potgietor of Sterkspruit, now Drummond, Peacevale and part of Hammarsdale. It was only after the English Government took over the rule of the Colony of Natal in 1843 that proper surveying was carried out and title to the farms was formally registered.

From a letter, in the archives, dated 15 Feb 1851, we know that William Swan Field purchased the farm Tafelberg from Andries van Tonderen in March 1845, at a time when some of the Dutch settlers were heading north to escape the hated British rule. The farm was surveyed in 1847 and on the title deed was named Richmond no. 999. These were the days when the area was occupied by very few whites and blacks and many wild animals roamed the countryside including lions and leopards, which were not unknown to seek shelter on the verandas of the homesteads. Very few elephants were left in the area but it is believed that old Jack, the brother of William Field tracked one from Pinetown to the Berea where it was killed. Oxwagons were the main means of moving goods and the wagon track from Durban to Pietermaritzburg passed through the area roughly along the route of the present Old Main Road. In 1879 the railway line reached Botha's Hill Station and by 1 December 1880 was officially opened to Pietermaritzburg. Within 5 years the oxwagon had almost disappeared.

History and Culture



Heritage

Inchanga, KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa

The Inchanga Station precinct, which includes the old Station Master's House, railway sheds and yards, is in its entirety a heritage site. The Station was opened for traffic in 1892 after the old Inchanga viaduct was closed and the route was re-aligned. The Station and stationmaster's house were built in 1895.

The Inchanga Railway Museum, which houses mainly smaller items, is operated and manned by volunteer members of the KZN Railway History Society. It relies solely on donations given by visitors.

The Museum is only open on days when Umgeni Steam Railway operates train trips between Kloof & Inchanga. For the next running day please see www.umgenisteamrailway.com.

An upgrade of the Museum commenced in 2018. Come and en-joy a trip down memory line.

Hammarisdale, KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa

The Mpumalanga Heritage Museum Centre is a site of memory and a reminder of an extraordinary time in the history of Mpumalanga. It tells a story of the political violence that engulfed Mpumalanga from 1983 to 1992, and how people of this community resolved to end this conflict and make peace with one another.

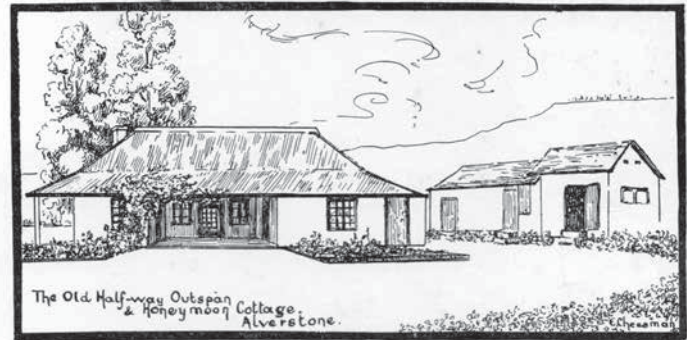

Heritage

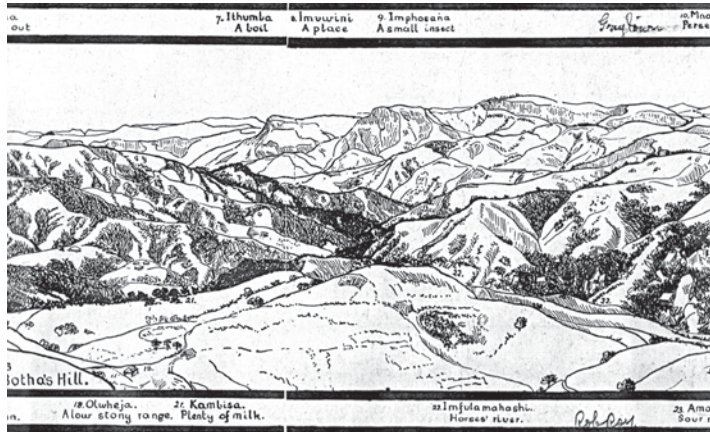
Clough's Halfway House was in operation by 1855 and was situated at the foot of Alverstone Hill. In 1860 Prince Alfred, the second son of Queen Victoria, stayed overnight and as a result, the name was changed to Clough's Royal Hotel. Within 5 years of the advent of the steam train, oxwagon traffic had died out and sounded the death knell for the Halfway House which closed in about 1884. The sketch on the right was drawn by local resident Edith Cheesman in about 1940.

The old building has had a chequered existence since then. In 1973 the derelict remains were renovated into a habitable cottage and a Cape Dutch style gable was added by its owner, KO Beier.

It was again abandoned and after a number of years of neglect, when, on the point of demolition in 2017, it was given a new lease on life by its present occupants. The photo on the right shows its appearance in 2021.



Heritage



The phrase Valley of a Thousand Hills is known internationally thanks to a great extent to the Comrades Marathon which is run along some of its ridges on the Old Main Road between Durban to Pietermaritzburg.

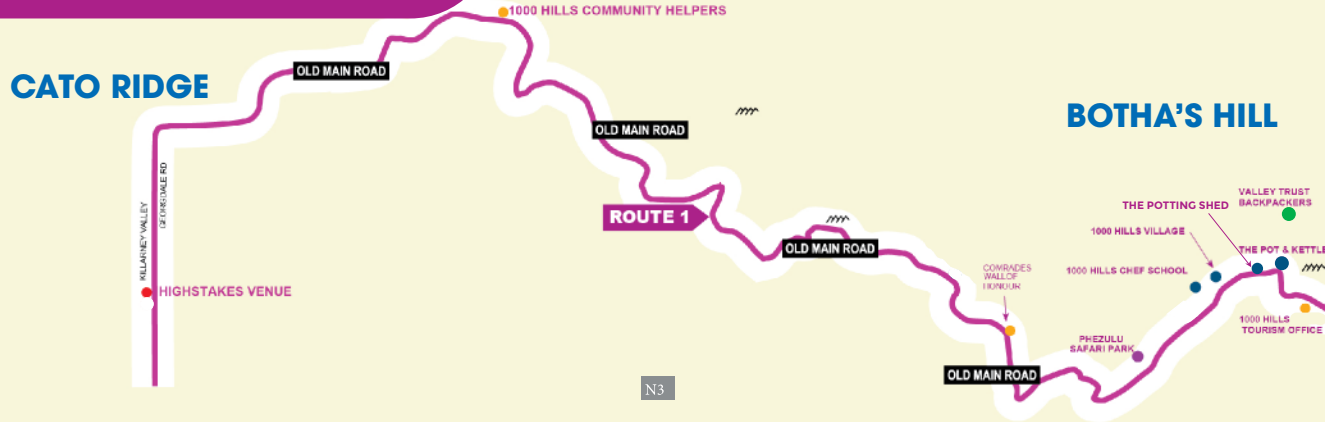
The sketch on the left drawn by Edith Cheesman about 80 years ago depicts the Valley and a few of its Hills as seen from Botha's Hill. On it she has named some of the Hills with both their Zulu and English names. The photo below shows approximately the same vista taken in 2021 by Paul Candow.

The origin of the Valley's name is uncertain, having been attributed by some to Mark Twain who visited Natal in May 1896. He travelled by train from Durban along the old main line passing Botha's Hill in the dark, therefore suggesting that this story may not be true.



Shortly before he died in 1910, well known author, Robert Russell wrote "The road now runs amongst swelling heights and opens up some magnificent scenery. Close at hand some immense rounded blocks of chrystalline granite appear to rest so lightly on the grassy slopes that only a vigorous push seems needed to topple them into the valley below. They are not however detached masses, but only those parts of the bed-rock that are hard enough to withstand for a time the crumbling effects of the elements. A vista of hills and valleys, like a mountainous sea congealed, stretches to the right far away into the wild Inanda country."

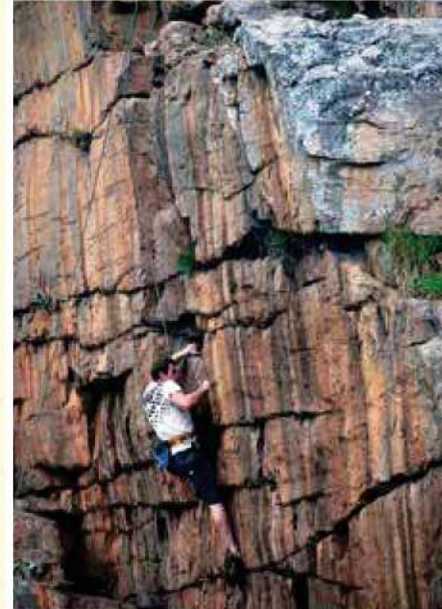
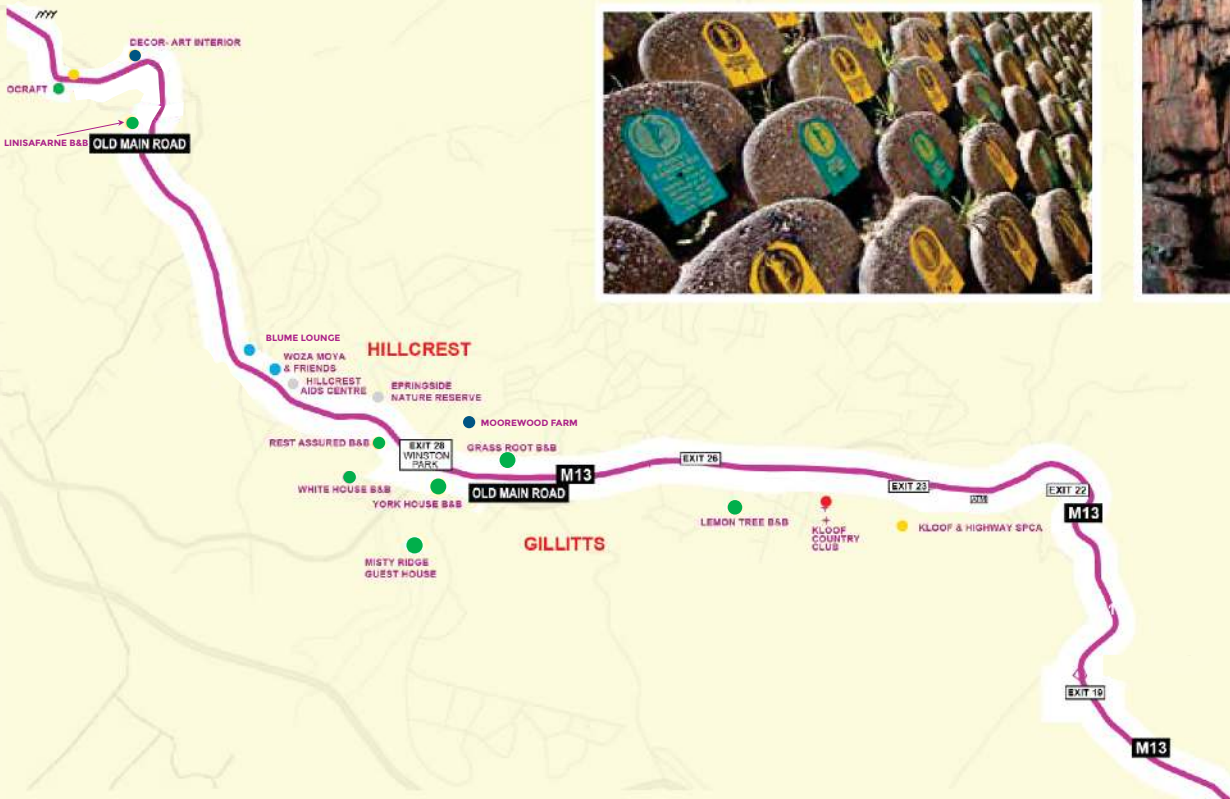
