When on the ground, you can choose from a number of our capable Shuttle service providers or Tour operators to assist you in moving around.



OHLANGE INSTITUTE

Ohlange Institute / School was founded in 1901 by the founding President of the African National Congress, Dr John Langalibalele Dube. The importance of this institution compeled Nelson Mandela, the globally acclaimed freedom fighter and South Africa's first democratically elected president, to vote there in April 27, 1994 when the country held its first all-races elections.

Dr John Langalibalele Dube was also the a founder of the first Zulu newspaper in 1903 called llanga laseNatali.

INANDA SEMINARY

Inanda Seminary is a Christian boarding school for girls, established in 1869 by American Board Missionaries: Rev. Daniel Lindley and wife Lucy Lindley. Started with 19 students and now has just over 400 students.

This historic Scholl has trully been a unique one in the area especially for girls. it has produced a number of pupils who would later become prominent citizens like the country's first women deputy president, PhumzileMlambo-Ngcuka.

PHOENIX SETTLEMENT

The Phoenix settlement was established in 1903 and the Sarvodaya house was built for Gandhi and his family. During the Inanda Riots in 1985 the house was burnt down and what you see today is a reconstruction of the original house.

When visiting the settlement and Gandhi's house you will be able to see the printing press on which the first Indian newspaper in South Africa was printed. Here you will also find photos of Gandhi in India and in South Africa.

NAZARETH BAPTIST CHURCH


Nazareth Baptist Church - commonly known as the Shembe Church is one of the largest traditional African churches in Africa, drawing members not only from South Africa, but also neighbouring countries like Swaziland and Lesotho. The church's first headquarters is found along the M25, at Ekuphakameni.

The Church was Founded by Isaiah Shembe in 1910.

SEME PRECINCT

Pixley Isaka Ka Seme was born in October 1881 in the then colony of Natal. He was initially educated at a local mission school, and then went to the United States of America on a missionary scholarship for further education, including university studies at the lvy League Columbia University in New York.

in 1912, Seme together with other African called for a convention of Africans to discuss their situation in South Africa and to look for peaceful means to change the status quo. The outcome of that call, of course, was the formation of the South African Native National Congress (SANNC), later renamed the African National Congress (ANC). Source: thepresidency.gov.za


INANDA ADVETURES BY THE DAM

Inanda is the richest place in the Country, there is more of South African history in that place than anywhere else. This heritage tour will take you to Ohlange institute founded by Dr JL Dube in 1900. Dr JL Dube was the first president of the ANC. Ohlange is also a Place where Nelson Mandela cast his First Democratic Vote in 1994.

Built in the early 1900

Another important site you will visit when on this Tour, is a Mahatma Gandhi settlement, established in 1904. Gandhi developed his movement & philosophy of passive resistance while staying in this settlement.

Inanda Seminary is the first secondary school for African girls and one of the oldest in South Africa and Africa, founded in 1869 by American missionaries. A visit to Inanda seminary is part of this tour.
