UMLAZI ... AT A GLANCE



Umlazi is a township on the East Coast of KwaZulu- Natal, South Africa, located South West of Durban. It lies along the south bank of the UMlazi River, hence its name of Umlazi.

It is divided into 26 sections, A through to Z, except for I, O, X, but an addition of AA, BB, CC. It also has a rural area called eNgonyameni, which stretches inland along eZimbokodweni River.

According to the legends, the word 'Umlazi' is derived from 'Umlaza' which is the sour acid produced from

a fermented or sour milk. It is believed that when King Shaka was passing through the area, he refused to drink from a local river claiming it had a taste of umlaza. The place was then called Umlazi after that incident.

This thriving township lifestyle destination offers almost everything for a discerning traveller. It's famous for its unique township experience, all yearround pleasant weather, rich heritage route, safe and buzzing pub and grills and last but not least its stylish and friendly people.

As South Africa's biggest township, Umlazi boasts an epic nightlife with its unique and state of the art outlets to satisfy any kind of entertainment enthusiast. So, visitors to this township should be prepared for some party hopping to get the thrill.

ATTRACTIONS

UMLAZI AMPHITHEATRE

Revamping of the amphitheatre is currently underway near Umlazi Mega City. The first phase, accommodating a 5000-seater is due for completion by September 2023. The facilities projected to become the arts and culture precinct and host of the communityTV station.


The house was once the home of the late struggle icons, husband and wife, Advocate Griffiths Mxenge and Advocate Victoria Mxenge. Both lost their lives fighting for human rights and the injustices of the apartheid regime, therefore their legacy will always be part of Umlazi's heritage and history. Converting their home to the township struggle was given a stamp of approval by their family and all relevant stakeholders.

ENGONYAMENI

The incredible scenery and the excellent chances of great encounters with wildlife species are some of the features that define the area of Engonyameni, which lies on the outskirts of Umlazi Township. This area is also adorned by the beautiful hills of Inwabi and Tafelkop, with the latter being believed is sacred and no one is encouraged to go there.

Hence there is no sign of normal habitation currently there. The other area that continues to attract visitors is Inkumba Forest which was planted by Baba Cele, the respected world-famous traditional healer who has been awarded locally and nationally for his contribution in the community. He normally hosts researchers from all over the world. Engonyameni provides an unparalleled experience for those who are determined to crisscross the unique hunting safaris and trail photographic safaris. Plans to have more wild adventures in Engonyameni are underway.

Mangosuthu University of Technology (MUT)



The Mangosuthu university of Technology is a residential university that is named after Mangosuthu Buthelezi who is the founder of a particular party and the traditional prime minister of the Zulu royal family. The university is in Umlazi just outside of Durbanbin the academic hub in the eThekwini metropole. Umlazi being the second largest township in South Africa, being historically significant for its culture of education excellence, MUT was then built in 1974, for the better empowerment of the youth, growth in communities in uMlazi." MUT is located in the academic hub in the eThekwini metropole. It is a residential university.

The history of the University begins in 1974 with Prince Mangosuthu Buthelezi, former Prime Minister in KwaZulu Homeland in apartheid South Africa. At a meeting with the Chairman of the Anglo American Corporation and De Beers Consolidated Mines, Mr Harry F Oppenheimer, Prince Buthelezi first put forward the idea of establishing a tertiary education institution specializing in technical subjects.

The proposal was taken up by the Anglo American and De Beers Chairman's Fund, and, although funds were not immediately available to construct such an institution, research was commissioned to investigate the potential in South Africa for the training and employment of black technicians. MUT is the only university in Umlazi amongst FET's and colleges.

King Zwelithini Stadium







King Zwelithini Stadium is a multi-purpose stadium in Umlazi, a township south-west of Durban, South Africa. It is currently used mostly for football matches and was initially set to be utilized as a training field for teams participating in the 2010 FIFA World Cup after being renovated in 2010 and brought up to FIFA standards. Its capacity was expanded from 5000 to 10 000 as the legacy of the world cup. The stadium is named after the Zulu King, Goodwill Zwelithini kaBhekuzulu.


